

b.solutions 2.0 – Cross-border energy communities

Period of performance: 2023

Successfully implementing the energy transition cannot lean only on large-scale projects, but requires the support of the population and the implementation of regional solutions. Renewable (citizen) energy communities are designed to offer a common form of organisation for such local solutions. However, the legal implementation at national level poses considerable problems in practice in border regions and for cross-border communities.
