


SEA for the Austrian CAP Strategic Plan 2023-2027

Period of Performance: 2020-2022

In the period of 2023-2027 for the first time a strategic plan for implementing the Common Agricultural Policy had to be drafted in Austria. This plan combines the former „Pillar 1“ (direct payments) and „Pillar 2“ (Rural Development) of the CAP funding. The CAP is of high importance as a funding scheme for Austria, both in terms of topics addressed as well due to its high financial volume.
