Transform+ is a complimentary to the FP7 project TRANSFORM. It shall provide the Vienna-based inputs, namely a Smart City Transformation Agenda, a permanent, city-wide Smart City-stakeholder process and the preparation of concrete data analysis and SC-implementation planning in two selected “Smart Urban Labs” in Vienna (Liesing-Groß Erlaa and aspern Seestadt).
