

Integration of SDGs into development strategies in the EU

Period of performance: 2022

The study analysed the incorporation of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in the European Semester, at the national level in the National Recovery and Resilience Plans (NRRPs) throughout EU as well as at local and regional level by the LRA in selected case study regions. Potential synergies between the interventions designed in the NRRPs and in the regional development strategies were investigated.
