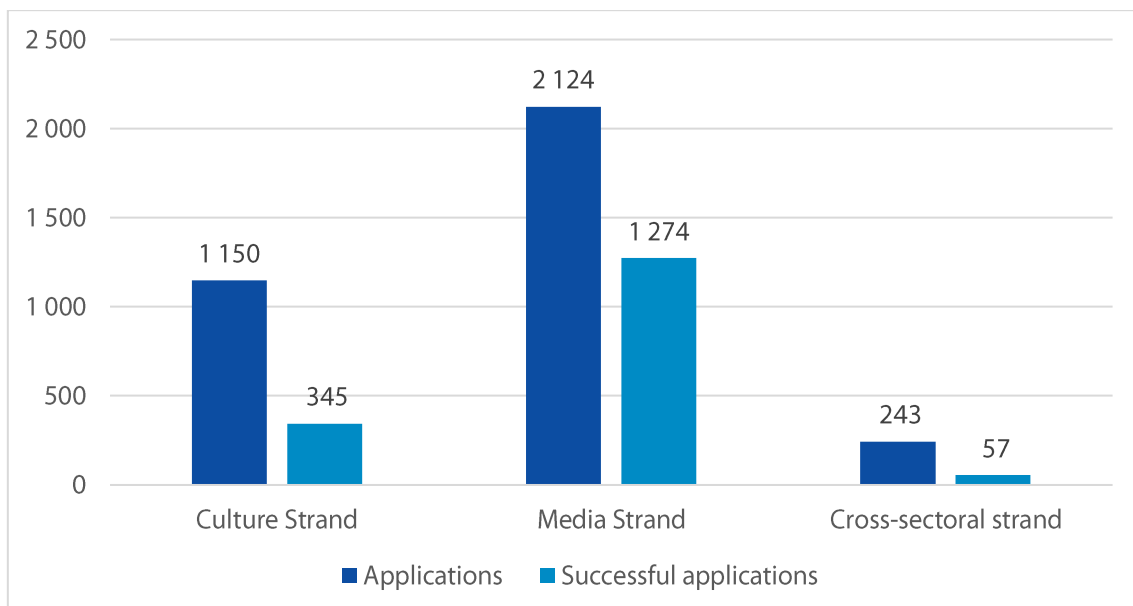


## Study on the early implementation of four EU programmes 2021-2027

Period of performance: 2023

The study, commissioned by the Research Services of the European Parliament (EPRS), evaluates the early implementation of the following four funding programmes: Erasmus+, Creative Europe, European Solidarity Corps and the Strand 3 of the Citizens, Equality, Rights and Values Programme (CERV). The evaluation focuses on the design and implementation activities over the 2021-2023 period in line with three evaluation dimensions: relevance, external coherence and first insights in the early implementation effectiveness of these four programmes.
