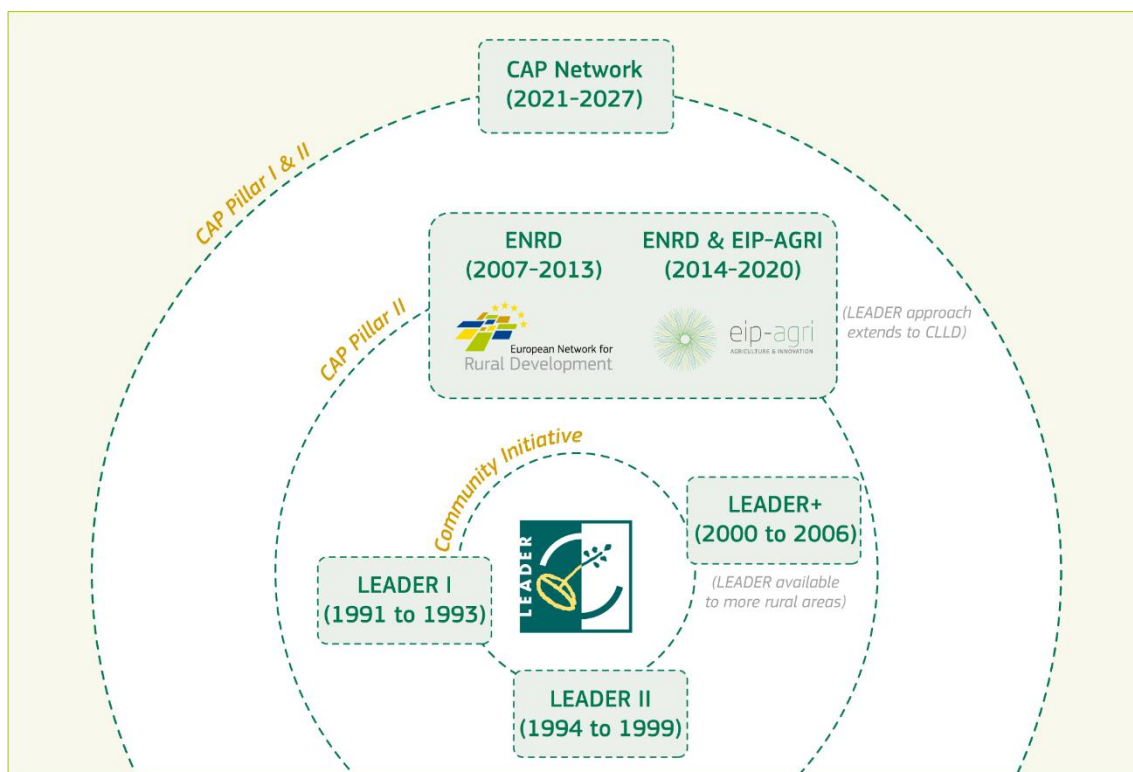


## Study on rural networks' contribution to the EAFRD

Period of performance: 2022-2023

The objective of this study was to evaluate the contributions of the European network for rural development (ENRD) and the national rural networks in the implementation of the EAFRD 2014-2022. The consortium undertaking this evaluation included ADE, ÖIR and the University of Gloucestershire.
